4. METHODS OF COMPETITION

A. Under 9 & 11, Cadet, Junior, Senior

- The best of three (3) system. (Excluding Color Belts)
- Male/Female : (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category.
(Under 9 Category Mixed Gender)
- Video replay is allowed once per match up to the quarterfinals, and once per match from the semifinals to the finals. (excluding Under 9)
- All competitors must wear WT or KTA officially-approved Taekwondo uniform(Dobok).
 - Club names and affiliated teams are allowed on the uniform.
- No PSS is used in Under 9. (No Instant Video Replay)
- Competitors should bring their own Mandatory Safety Equipment.
- **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition. The Organizing Committee will provide **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

B. Color Belts Kyorugi

- Based on the height and weight information submitted at registration, tournament will be made up of 4 competitors for each category.
 - If the height and weight of competitors are different on the competition day, the match list may be subject to change.
- A tournament can be integrated when the number of competitors in each division (years or Belts) is less than 4.
- No PSS is used in Color Belts Kyorugi.
- Competitors should bring their own Mandatory Safety Equipment.

5. COMPETITION RULES : Latest WT Competition Rules shall be applied.

6. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Color Belts Kyorugi : 1 minute x 2 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Under 9 & 11 : 1 minute x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Cadet : 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Junior : 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds (30 seconds break time)
- Senior : 2 minute x 3 rounds (1 minute break time)

7. WEIGH-IN

※ No weigh-in for Color Belts Kyorugi

- All competitors should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise will be disqualified.
- The Weigh-in will be conducted twice a day, and an athlete may only participate in one weigh-in session.
- Weigh-in of the Competitors shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition. (Time and location will be noticed later)
- Weigh-in shall be conducted once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time. (approximately two hours)
- During weigh-in, the Male contestant shall wear underpants and the female contestant shall wear underpants and a brassiere. However, weigh-in may be conducted in the nude if the contestant wishes to do so.
- The competitors participating in Under 9, 11, Cadet and Junior categories must be weighed with underwear(s) on and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.

8. OTHERS

- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.
- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure-Taekwondo.
- When the number of contestants in a category or weight class is less than four(4), they will be combined with the next higher weight class.
- ※ If there are 2 contestants in the Under 9 competitions -23kg class and 3 constestants in the -25kg class, they will be combined. (Up to two weight classes)
 - The weigh-in will be conducted based on the initially registered weight class.
 - If there are less than four(4) participants due to disqualification, failure to show at weigh-in, or being unable to participate due to merged weight classes, only medals will be awarded. (no certificates will be given, and the results will not be considered official)
 - The cases of integrated weight class are accepted as an official result.
- In cases of clear system errors(such as changes in participant categories or missing participants), the athlete will be added to the last match number of their category.
- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.

3. DURATION OF CONTEST : Up to 90 seconds

- The waiting period between 1st poomsae and 2nd poomsae is a 30sec to 60sec.
- Exceeding the time, score deduction shall be applied.

4. DETAILS OF EACH COMPETITIONS

A. Methods Of Competition

- Single elimination tournament System shall be applied to the Poomsae Competition.
- In principle, if there are fewer than four participants (or four teams) in a division, it shall be combined with another division; however, if such a combination is not possible, a demonstration competition may be conducted.
- If there are fewer than four(4) participants, only medals will be awarded.
(No certificates will be given, and the results will not be considered official.)
- All competitors must wear WT or KTA officially-approved Taekwondo uniform(Dobok).
- Club names and affiliated teams are allowed on the uniform.
- Mixed Team : There is no limit on the mixed-gender ratio.

B. The competition area for Recognized Poomsae : 10m×10m

C. Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- **Latest WT Competition Rules shall be applied.**
- Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.

D. Compulsory Poomsae

- It is compulsory to perform two types of Poomsae in each entry.
- The Compulsory Poomsae will be randomly selected during the Head of Team Meeting via an electronic drawing

- If the above is still tied: the athlete of a weight class who participated in the most games is prioritized.
- If the above is still tied: the athlete with the most points will be prioritized.
- If the above is still tied: the athlete with the fewer lost points will be prioritized.
- If the above is still no decision: The competition management team will make the final decision.

- Team Awards

- "Gold" takes priority over "Silver", and "Silver" takes priority over "Bronze".
- If there is a tie, the team with the most medals in the most games will be prioritized.
- Overall competition awards will only be given to teams that participate in 4 or more weight classes.
- For cases of failure to weigh-in or disqualification due to weight-related issues, the team's composition and the total number of participants will be excluded from the final count.
- If the above is still a tie, the team with the most athletes advancing to the Top 8 or Top 16 will be prioritized, but still tied then the ranking will be determined by weight class.

2. INDEMNITY

- A. Organizing Committee effects accident insurance for all competitors during the competition only.
- B. Only first-aid treatment is available for wounds from the competition.

3. PARTICIPATION SUPPORT
